

2011 Defensive Pistol

New for this year.... There will be three stages of fire all related to the use of a pistol under defensive situations.

First stage will be an open air style shoot house with multiple targets throughout. Start position, round count, and number of targets may vary from match to match.

Second stage will be similar to the first but on a smaller scale with a few surprises of its own. There again start position, round count, and number of targets may vary.

Third stage will be an El Presidente course to test your speed and on target hits. All three stages will be for total time plus penalties added for misses and not using concealment during engagement of targets.

Start Procedure.

Start positions may vary from stage to stage however the beginning will be the same. When it is your turn to shoot you will come to the table with your pistol unloaded and bagged. The RSO will instruct you to unbag the pistol and show clear, slide forward, hammer down and then holster pistol.

When ready to start the course the RSO will instruct you to draw your pistol and insert a loaded magazine and reholster. (You will **NOT** chamber a round.) At the buzzer you will draw, rack the slide, and engage the targets as they appear throughout the course. This start procedure will be used on both shoot house stages.

The El Presidente will be shot from a distance of ten yards with three targets three feet apart.

Start procedure for El Presidente

You will bring your bagged unloaded pistol to the table. After showing the RSO that the pistol is clear, you will be instructed to holster your pistol. When you are ready to start the RSO will instruct you to draw your pistol, load a magazine and reholster with an empty chamber. You will have your back to the targets and hands at surrender position. At the buzzer you will turn 180 degrees, draw, chamber a round, and engage each target twice. You will then do a reload and engage each target twice again for a total of twelve rounds. This stage will be shot twice for a total round count of twenty-four.

Equipment Requirements: Holsters are required for this match (NO EXCEPTIONS).

Magazine holders are highly suggested. Holster must fit the pistol and cover the trigger. In the waistband holster's (IWB) will be allowed. There will be no inside the pocket holsters allowed.

Pistols calibers allowed will be as follows: .380, 9mm, 357 sig, .40 cal, and 45 ACP

Revolver calibers allowed:

38 special only you may use your 357 magnum but must be loaded with .38 special ammo. **No single action revolvers allowed.** Round count for the three stages combined will never exceed 100 rounds.
